CONDITIONS OF TESTING

1. Official working hours are from 9:00am to 6:00pm. Monday to Friday. Applications received after 2:00pm will be considered as submission of the following working day.
2. **REGULAR SERVICES** usually take 5 -7 working days after receipt of samples, subject to the tests required.
3. **EXPRESS SERVICES** are available for certain tests and the results are usually available within 3 - 4 working days after receipt of samples, according to the tests required. There is an express surcharge of 50%.
4. **DOUBLE EXPRESS SERVICES** are available for some tests and results are available within 1-2 working days at a surcharge of 100%.
5. The above turnaround times for Regular, Express, and Double Express Services are a general guideline for reference only. They are subjected to amendment from time to time. The actual and valid turnaround time is normally shown on the relevant quotation for your reference.
6. When an application requires several different kinds of test services, the test report will not be issued until all tests are completed. Upon request, the result of the completed tests will be given verbally.
7. Overseas Facsimile, Telex, Cable and Postage Costs as incurred, are for account of client.
8. Testing fees and any incidental expenses are payable within 30 days of date of invoice. Otherwise, 5% monthly interest will be charged.
9. There is a minimum charge of HK\$200 per report issued.
10. Tested samples not destroyed may be reclaimed after testing if so indicated on the application form and will normally retained for a maximum period of 90 days.
11. Conditions and testing fees are subjected to change without prior notice.
